Pupils should extend their knowledge and understanding beyond the local area to include the United Kingdom, Europe, North and South America. This will include the location and characteristics of a range of the world's most significant human and physical features.</p> <p>They should develop their use of geographical knowledge, understanding, and skills to enhance their locational and place knowledge.</p> <p>Pupils will be taught to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Locate the world's countries using maps to focus on Europe</li> <li>● Name and locate countries and cities of UK.
